Louis C. K. (comedian and producer)	-sexual misconduct with 5 women	Owened up to it and admitted its true	FX and other companies cut ties and his movie was cancelled
Matt Lauer (host of Today Show)	-Female Colleague accused him of inappropriate sexual behavior -others accused him of sexual misconduct too	Apologized to the people but said some of the accusations	Fired from Today Show
Charlie Rose (TV Host)	-sexual harassment of at least 8 women	Accepts some of the accusations but not all	Fired by CBS and TV Show "Charlie Rose" cancelled

Donald Trump (President)	-over 20 women accusing of sexual assault -vulgar video	-He admitted and apologized for the vulgar video and dismissed it as "locker talk", and now denies the video -denies sexual harassment allegations	Still in office
Al Franken (MN Senate)	-Accused of forcibly kissing and groping	He apologized for everything and takes responsibility	Still in office
Roy Moore (Senator)	-5 women accused him of sexual assault (one of them a 14 year old)	Denied all accusations	Still in office (getting looked at to be replaced)
John Conyers (former staffer)	-unwanted sexual advances	Denied any wrong doing	Still in office (being pressured to resign)
